IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Please bring your own safety pins
- Swap your race licence for your timing chip.
No licence? We take driving licences, passports or bank cards
- Wear your timing chip on your LEFT ankle with the chip facing outwards.
Top tip - pull your sock over the chip to keep it in place
- When you finish your race, head straight to the podium
- Return your timing chip as soon as possible after your race podium celebration

HOW TO GET HERE

By Car & Van

Satnav postcode: HP22 4BY

Buckinghamshire Railway Centre is on the outskirts of Quainton, a village situated halfway between Bicester and Aylesbury just off the A41, and south of Buckingham.

Watch out for our brown railway attraction signs to the A413 at Whitchurch. If you are coming from Aylesbury direction, due to lots of new housing developments which upset some SatNav systems, we advise you to remain on the A41 until you reach the new Blackgrove Road roundabout, then follow the signs.

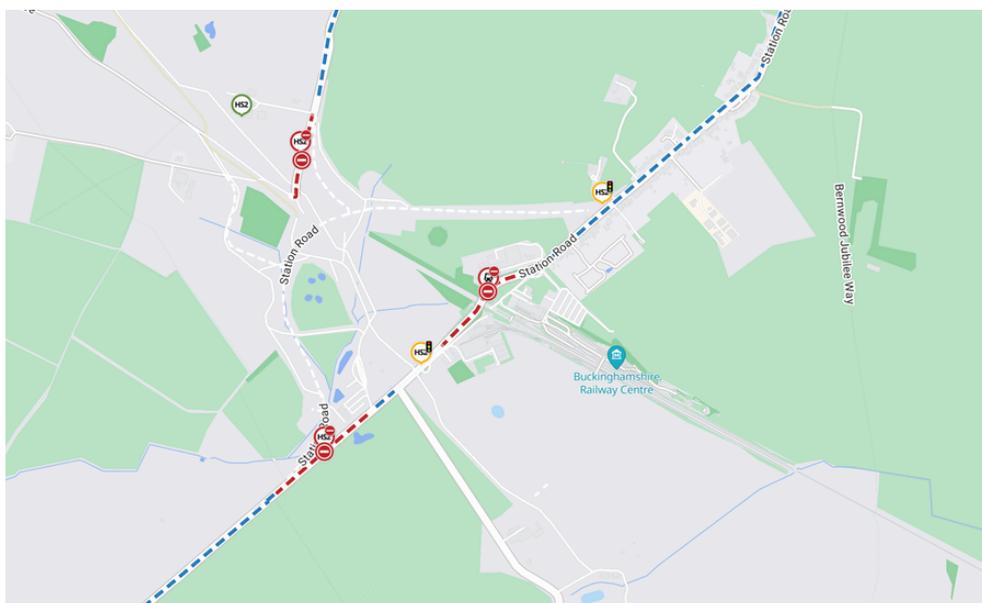

Current road closures

One Network is currently showing the road Southwest of BRC as closed, so the only way in is through Quainton and South down Station Road. This is a 30mph zone so please observe the speed limit all the way down to the Railway Centre.

Junctions 7, 8 and 9 of the M40 are all close by and the M1, M25, M4 and M40 network makes the Centre easily accessible from London, the Southeast and the Midlands.



PARKING

On arrival at the Railway Centre, you'll be greeted by marshals. Please follow their instructions to park correctly. We have a pretty big car park, but it's not marked so we need you to make a nice line of vehicles.

To help us with our mission to teach as many young people as possible to cycle, we will be charging £3 per vehicle for parking. Please have your exact £3 cash ready. We'll be using all funds to buy equipment to help our volunteers teach future riders!

REGISTRATION AND RACE HQ

Registration will be open from 8:30 at Race HQ. This is in the showground. Follow the signs around the station building and past the train sheds to the showground.

U14's and older riders will need to pay for a day licence if you do not have a valid British Cycling membership (£5.00).

We have bike racks laid out, so please rack all bikes before going to sign-on. Do not bring your bike to sign on.

TIMING CHIPS

After registration you will be given a timing chip, these **MUST** be worn on your left ankle (not on the bike).

You will need your BC Race Licence for sign on to exchange for your CHIP and RACE NUMBER (or provide another form of collateral).

After you've finished your race, make your way directly to the podium to celebrate you and your fellow participants achievements. When that's all done, you will need to return your chip to registration in order to recover your licence.

When you return your chip, don't forget to treat yourself to some sweets from race control.

NUMBERS AND PINS

You will be given a race number at registration at the same time as you are given your chip. Numbers are to be pinned to your back so as they are not obscured by clothing, or long hair.

With sustainability and running costs in mind, CCXL would like to remind you to please bring your own pins to every round and reuse these wherever possible throughout the season.

FOOD AND DRINK

Coffee and cake will be provided by Great Gelato. They are close friends to our club and we're looking forward to having them at our race on Sunday. Get that pre-race charge or post-race recover drink from them!

Vaz from Friends & Flavours will be on site providing the hot food including burgers, fries and combo boxes.

To compliment the fries, we have Wendover Beers visiting us. Jim is a club friend and has over 15 years of brewing experience. He will be returning with his delicious mulled cider, perfect for a cold day and great with fries. If you'd like a canned beer, they will also be available, plus you can pick up a gift pack - perfect as a present for Christmas.

TOILETS

Toilets can be found at the museum behind Race HQ. If you're not sure where they are, ask one of the marshals and they will direct you to the toilets.

Note: all race timings are approximate and subject to change on the day.

For sighting laps, you must enter only where indicated by the flag with smiley face on.

Please do not enter/exit at any other point of the course.

GRIDDING

Gridding will take place close to the starting area of the race. Please arrive at the start area at least 10 minutes before the race is due to start to assist with gridding.

Gridding is for pre-entered riders only. Entries on the day will join at the back of the grid.

PRIZES AND RESULTS

Podiums will be announced as soon as possible after each race has finished and results have been verified. Live results will be available on the day at

PITS

The pits are dual-sided and are in the centre of the race field. They can be accessed via a marshalled point. Please only access the pits if you're supporting a rider within the current race or collecting equipment from a previous race.

If you need water you'll find a tap behind the Race HQ.

There's no issue with petrol powered pressure washers but have a thought about your fellow riders and spectators when operating.

PLEASE DO NOT CROSS THE COURSE TO ACCESS THE PITS UNLESS AT A CROSSING POINT.

FIRST AID

Should you need assistance, please look for the First Aid providers or a Marshal who will contact First Aid on your behalf on their radio.

Should you need emergency assistance, the nearest hospital is Stoke Mandeville.

REMINDER POINTS

- Car Park - £3 cash required
- Swap your race license for your timing chip
- Bring your own pins
- Timing chip on left ankle
- **RETURN** your timing chip post-race
- Race hard and then celebrate the podium winners
- Have fun and respect others

We'd also like to thank all the Race Organisers from all the other rounds. Your support is always invaluable.

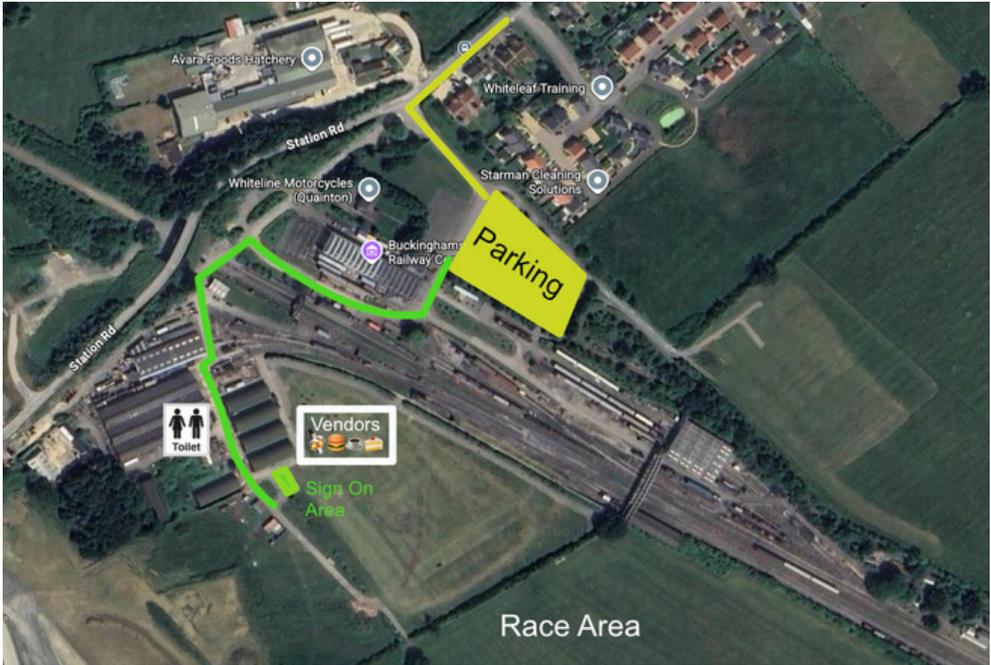

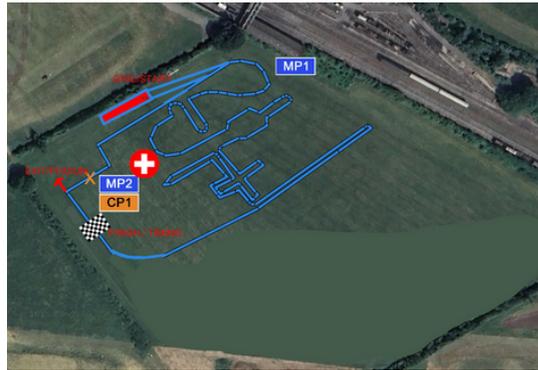
SITE MAP



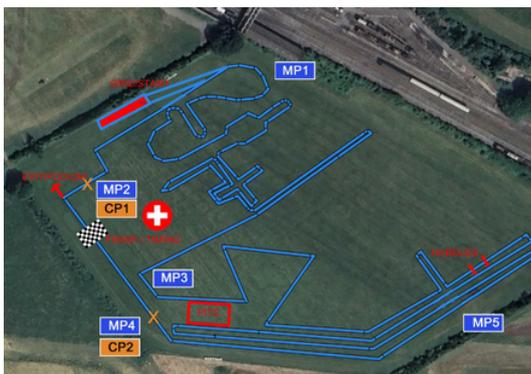
COURSE MAP
